Mildred Bergman Rites Conducted

Mrs. Mildred See Bergman, 68, the wife of Ralph W. Bergman of St. Louis, Mo., passed away Thursday morning at a St. Louis hospital following a lingering illness.

The daughter of Conaway B. and Matilda J. Parmley See, Mrs. Bergman was born in Grinnell on Sept. 22, 1901. She attended the Grinnell schools and graduated with the Class of 1919. On June 17, 1939, she was married to Ralph W. Bergman at St. Louis, Mo. They lived in St. Louis since 1939 where she was a member of St. Casimir Catholic church.

Survivors include her husband, Ralph; two brothers and one sister — Raymond See of Grinnell, Jack See of Des Moines and Mrs. E. W. (Gladys) Kaltenbach of Rockford, Ill.

Mrs. Bergman was preceded in death by her parents and two brothers—Donald W. See in 1960 and a brother in infancy.

Requiem Mass for Mildred Bergman was held at 9 a.m. Saturday at St. Casimir Catholic church in St. Louis.

Prayer services were held at 10 a.m. this morning (Monday) at the Smith Funeral Home with the Rev. Bernard Kamerick, pastor of St. Patrick's Catholic church in Brooklyn, officiating. Organist was Mrs. Willard Heffner.

Burial was in Hazelwood Cemetery.
