Mrs. G. W. Binegar, wife of
ex-Sheriff Binegar, died at her home
in Montezuma, aged 63 years, after a
long illness from tuberculosis. Her
maiden name was Hulda Sheley and
her parents were pioneer settlers of
the county. She was the mother of
eleven children, seven of whom sur-
vive. Mr. and Mrs. Binegar first re-
sided on a farm in Sugar Creek town-
ship but in 1897, following Mr. Bine-
gar's election as sheriff, the family
home was moved to Montezuma, where
it has been ever since. The funeral
was held last Friday and interment
was in the Montezuma cemetery.
