G. W. Binegar, wife of ex-Sheriff Binegar, died at her home in Montezuma, aged 63 years, after a 'ong illness from tuberculosis. Her maiden name was Hulda Sheley and her parents were pioneer settlers of the county. She was the mother of eleven children, seven of whom survive. Mr. and Mrs. Binegar first resided on a farm in Sugar Creek township but in 1897, following Mr. Binegar's election as sheriff, the family home was moved to Montezuma, where it has been ever since. The funeral vas held last Friday and interment vas in the Montezuma cemetery.
