Agnes Agnew Richie was born in County Down, Ireland, Nov. 20, 1819, and departed this life Friday morning, Nov. 8, 1907, aged 87 years, 11 months and 22 days.

In 1840 she married John Black-stock. To this union were born eight children; four in Ireland and four in America. Mr. Blackstock passed away on Oct. 27, 1873, and the youngest daughter died at the age of thirteen years. The remaining children are still living. They are: Agnes Ferson of Ewart; John of Lucas Co.; David and Hugh of Rock Island; William of Pennsylvania; Alex of Lucas Co.; and James of Clarinda.

Mr. and Mrs. Blackstock with their children came to America in 1850 and three years later moved to Rural, Ill., where they lived for many years.

Mrs. Blackstock made profession of her faith and united with the church when twelve years of age, and has lived a consistent Christian life. For over 40 years she lived in the bounds of Homestead congregation near Coal Valley, Ill., of which church she remained a member until the time of her death.
