MRS. SARAH LOOMIS BLACKWELL.

In Longmont, Monday, June 17, 1901, of cancer of the liver, Mrs Sarah Loomis Blackwell died, aged 81 years, 5 months and 12 days. Mrs. Blackwell was born at Skowhegan, Maine. Has lived in Illinois and Iowa, and came to Colorado in 1898. She was the mother of S. H. Blackwell of this city. She was a Baptist by faith, but owing to the infirmities of age has been unable to attend church much of late years. As Mr. Blackwell was out of town it was difficult to locate him, but Wednesday a telegram was received from him saying that he would be home Saturday. Funeral services will be held Sunday afternoon at 1:30 at the house, when the remains will be sent to Geneseo, Ill., for burial, the embalming being done by E. G. Jones.—Longmont (Colo.) Leader, June 21. Mrs. Blackwell lived in the vicinity of Grinnell from '66 till '97 and leaves a very large number of friends here to mourn her loss.
