

11-23 EDWARD BLOCK 1920

Edward Rudolph Block was born in Oslova Creis Schwatz, West Prussia, Germany, February 21, 1860, and came to America in October 1876, residing near Malcom, Iowa until his sickness last February. He died Nov. 12, 1920. He leaves to mourn his loss three brothers, Frederick W. of Brooklyn, Ferdinand D. and David R. of Hartwick, and two sisters, Mrs. Augusta Blankenfeld of Geneseo, Ill., and Mrs. Louis Block of Malcom, Iowa and a host of other relatives. He became a member of the German Lutheran church at the age of fourteen. Funeral services were held at the church of Christ in Hartwick last Saturday conducted by Elder H. B. Smith, followed by interment in the Hartwick cemetery.—Victor Record.
