

## Harry Bogart, 69 Dies Wednesday; Funeral Saturday

Funeral services for Harry B. Bogart, 69, who died Wednesday afternoon at a local hospital following a brief illness, will be held at 1:00 p.m. Saturday from the Smith Funeral Home with Dr. G. S. Bruland of the Methodist church officiating.
