Louis Clifford Bouma, son of Cornelius and Elizabeth Otcheck Bouma, was born in Sully, Iowa, on June 28, 1893, and passed away in the Community hospital in Grinnell early Sunday morning, March 22, at the age of 70 years, 8 months, 24 days.

Louis had resided all of his life in the Lynnville-Sully area. Among many other things, he served as city marshal, was a member of the town council and Mayor of Lynnville. He was a brick and plaster mason by trade.
