Rites Wednesday For Glenn Bowen

Glenn Bowen, 88, a resident of the Mayflower Home in Grinnell, passed away Monday morning at Friendship Manor following an extended illness.

The son of George L. and Arabelle Rider Bowen, he was born on June 23, 1879, in Carlton Township, Tama County, near Garwin, Iowa. He attended rural schools of that community and was a graduate of Le Grand Academy and Cornell College at Mt. Vernon, Ia.

He was united in marriage on January 23, 1906, to Evalyn Talbot at Toledo. They established a lumber, grain and coal business at New Sharon, and in 1909 moved to Scarsboro where Mr. Bowen operated this same business for 46 years. He and his wife moved to Grinnell in 1952. After the death of his wife in April of 1956, he made his home at Mayflower Home.

He is survived by his daughter Mrs. Roland Eske of Mitchell, Iowa, his son Ralph P. Bowen of Pensacola, Fla., five granddaughters and ten great grandchildren, a sister Ruth Bowen of Lansing, Mich., and a brother Eugene of Glennview, Ill.

Besides his wife, he was preceded in death by his parents and two brothers.

Funeral services for Glenn Bowen will be Wednesday at 1:20 p.m. at the James-Schalinske Funeral Home, with burial at the Friends Cemetery at Lynnville.
