**William Boyd  
Dies At Age 74**

Funeral services for William Boyd, long-time Deep River resident, were held Monday morning, Aug. 13, at the Deep River Methodist Church, with the Rev. Wm. Morehouse officiating. A Masonic service was held at the church, with interment at Hampton, Iowa.

Casket bearers were Robert McWilliams, Forest McLain, Cecil McMains, Marvin Cranston, Harry McCullough, and Newell Keller. Mrs. Robert Doonan played the organ selections.

William was born the son of Hattie and George Boyd, near Dysart, Iowa, Nov. 25, 1887. He departed this life at the St. Luke's Methodist hospital, Cedar Rapids, Aug. 10, at the age of 74. He attended the local rural school and later the Tilford Academy in Vinton.

Oct. 20, 1909, he was united in marriage with Gladys Rohder. To this union one daughter was born. They made their home on a farm near Dysart and later moved to LaPort City. In 1933 they moved to their present home in Deep River, where he was engaged in business.

He was an active member of the Methodist church, The Masonic Order, and Golden Rod Lodge No. 512 AF & AM.

He is survived by his daughter, Virginia, and son-in-law, Karl Roegner, of Iowa Falls; two grandsons, Norman and Leland; four great granddaughters, two sisters, Mrs. Al Silverman, of Deep River, and Mrs. Margarette Milneof, of Marshalltown; two brothers, John of California and Robert of Texas; other relatives and many friends.
