

George Bradley Funeral Today; Accident Victim

Funeral services for George F. Bradley, 65, of Cedar Rapids, were held at the Smith Funeral Home today with the Rev. John DeLong, minister of the Methodist church, officiating.

A former Poweshiek county resident, he died December 21st at Cedar Rapids of injuries received when he was struck by an automobile.
