

## Ex-Supervisor Braley dies

Clifford Braley, 91, of Montezuma died at his home Thursday, Dec. 11.

Funeral services were conducted at 1:30 p.m. Saturday at the Steffy Funeral Home in Montezuma, with burial at the Pleasant Township Cemetery, Ewart.

The son of Ben and Lula Braley, he was born Dec. 3, 1889, near Kellogg. He attended local rural schools and

graduated from Grinnell High School in 1910.

On Dec. 3, 1915, he was married to Annette McCormick. The couple had five children. Mr. and Mrs. Braley lived in the Ewart area where they farmed.

He served as a Poweshiek County supervisor for several years. He was a member of the United Presbyterian Church of Ewart, where he served as an elder, and was a 50-year member of the Masonic Lodge.

Following the death of his wife Nettie in 1960, he maintained their home until his marriage to Florence Steffy in 1962.
