

## ELMER BRALEY KILLED

Elmer Braley, 40 a farmer living near Kellogg, was found dead about two and a half miles southeast of Kellogg at 10 o'clock Friday morning. It is thought that he had been dead twenty-four hours when found and that he had been accidentally killed by the discharge of a rifle as he attempted to go through a wire fence some time Thursday morning. The bullet entered just below the heart.

Mr. Braley leaves four children, Ross aged ten, Dale aged twelve, Florence, a Freshman in the Kellogg High school and a daughter two years of age. Mrs. Braley died last May.

Just about three weeks ago while Mr. Braley was in Newton on business his home burned.

Since the death of Mrs. Braley last spring Florence has been living with an aunt and the little girl has been adopted by another aunt.

Mr. Braley was born near Kellogg. He was married sixteen years ago and since that time has been engaged in farming.

Mrs. A. H. Raymond, of near Newton, and Mrs. N. R. Barnes, of this city, are sisters of Mrs. Braley.
