Henry Brauer, 67, Dies In Grinnell

Henry Brauer, 67, of 610 Pearl Street, Grinnell, passed away on Wednesday morning at Community Hospital following an extended illness.

He had recently been hospitalized in the Veterans Hospital in Iowa City.

Mr. Brauer was the son of Wilke H. and Sarah F. Hancock Brauer, and was born at Waukegan, Iowa, on November 24, 1899. During World War I, he enlisted in the United States Army and served as a baker with the General Hospital No. 38 in East View, N. Y.

After his discharge from the Army, Mr. Brauer made his home in Lincoln, Neb., for a number of years. For the past five years he has lived with his brother in Grinnell.

He is survived by his brother Carl, his widow Iona, and one step-daughter.

He was preceded in death by his parents, one son who died in childhood, and three brothers.

Funeral services for Henry Brauer will be conducted later this week at the Umberger Funeral Home in Lincoln, Neb. Burial will be in the veteran's section of Wyuka Cemetery at Lincoln.
