

Montezuma Man Found Dead In Home On Friday

A lifelong Montezuma resident, Bert Brazee, 67, succumbed at his home there last Friday afternoon.

Brazee had retired upstairs to his room following lunch that day and when called by his sister about 4:00 p.m., failed to respond. The sister, Mrs. Oscar Lofgren, did not investigate immediately but discovered the body about one hour later.

Following examination by the coronor, Dr. W. M. Page, it was revealed that he had been dead for several hours. Brazee was afflicted with a heart condition.

Prior to his death, he had been employed as a clerk in a Montezuma store. Never married, he is survived by three sisters.
