

Hazel Breckenridge

Hazel E. Breckenridge, 86, of Friendship Manor, a former Kellogg resident, died of a stroke Monday, March 2, at University Hospitals in Iowa City.

Funeral services were conducted Thursday at the Kellogg Christian Church, with the Rev. Mike Johnson officiating. Organist was Ann Buchmeier.
