Robert A. Breiting, 78, of 710 Eighth Ave., Grinnell, died Thursday, Sept. 28, at Iowa Methodist Medical Center in Des Moines.

A memorial service was conducted Sunday afternoon at St. John's Lutheran Church, with the Rev. Arvid Dixen officiating. Organist was Margaret Amo. The body was cremated.
