

Brimmer Funeral Here Last Friday

George N. Brimmer, 89, died Wednesday, March 10, at Community hospital in Grinnell where he had been admitted five days previously. Mr. Brimmer, a resident of Poweshiek county all of his life, had been in poor health for several months and had suffered a severe stroke the day before his death.

He had lived north of Brooklyn with his brother, John, for many years. Since last July he had lived in the home of Mrs. Golda Walker in Brooklyn. Mr. Brimmer, the son of George Oneida Brimmer and Catherine McLennan Brimmer, had never married.

He is survived by a brother, John Brimmer, and a sister, Mrs. Joan Beadle, both of Brooklyn. Preceding him in death were a brother and two sisters, Nealy Brimmer, Mrs. Balzer (Mary) Kriegel and Mrs. John (Charlotte) Hutchins.

Funeral services were conducted last Friday afternoon at two o'clock at Bramer Funeral Home in charge of the Rev. George Roquet, pastor of First United Presbyterian church. Mrs. Ed Bartachek was organist.

Burial was in Kent cemetery with Claude Shaffer, Dean Hawkins, Dale Hawkins, Robert Gritsch, Leslie Showalter and Vere Osborne serving as pallbearers.
