

**Mrs. Ada Brown, 95  
Former Resident  
Dies In California**

Mrs. Ada Brown, 95, a former Grinnell resident, died in Arlington, Calif. on July 31st after a long illness. She suffered a broken hip in a fall in February, 1956.

She had made her home with a daughter and son-in-law in Corona, Calif. since the death of her husband, George Brown in Sept., 1924. Mrs. Brown was a former member of the Congregational church in Grinnell and a longtime member of the Searchlight Club.

They moved to Corona from their home at 811 8th Ave. in Grinnell in Sept., 1923.

Mrs. Brown was born at Davenport on June 30th, 1863 and married to George Brown in

Nov., 1889.

She is survived by a daughter, Dorothy Brown Lisle of Corona, Calif.; one granddaughter, two great grandchildren, two nieces and one nephew.

Funeral services were conducted Aug. 2nd at the Corona Methodist church with the Rev. Bruce Ellis officiating. Interment was at Sunnyslope cemetery at Corona.
