

Clayton Brown Funeral Rites

Funeral services were held today at 2 p.m. at the Smith Funeral home for Clayton Herbert Brown, 74, who died Tuesday at University Hospital in Iowa City after an illness of about two years.

Survivors include four half brothers and four half sisters. A sister, Vannie Brown, preceded him in death.

He was born May 26, 1883, in Monticello, Ky. He had lived in Grinnell for the last two years. He had lived in Montezuma for nine years and had farmed in Sheridan township and the Grinnell area for the last 50 years.
