## Former Grinnellian Dies In Nebraska

Ura C. Brown, 64, of Sidney, Nebr. and formerly of Grinnell died on Tuesday, April 4, in a Sidney hospital. Mr. Brown, who was a veteran employee of Western Electric Co., had been in failing health for several years and had retired Feb. 1, with more than 30 years service with Western Electric. He was honored at a special event upon his retirement.

Funeral services were held on Friday afternoon, April 7, at the First Methodist Church in Sidney. Masonic rites were conducted and interment was in Greenwood Cemetery, Sidney.

He was born on Feb. 13, 1903 at Deep River, the son of the late Mr. and Mrs. Everett Brown. He married Leona M. Greenwood in Sidney on Dec. 16, 1945. In addition to his wife, he is survived by two sons, Floyd of Scottsdale, Ariz., and Ronald H. of Fort Lee, N. J., and five grandchildren. He also is survived by one sister, Mrs. Myron Millhollin of Grinnell; three brothers, George of Mt. Vernon, Iowa, Ellis also of Grinnell, and Fred of Omaha, Nebr.

The deceased attended the Grinnell schools and also was a student at Iowa State College, Ames for two years. He was a member of the First Methodist Church in Sidney, the Elks, and Tehama Shrine, and other church and civic organizations.
