Lemert C. Brush Dies In Arkansas

Lemert C. Brush of Mountain Home, Ark., a former Lynnville resident, died Monday, Nov. 20 of a heart attack.

The son of D. E. and Rosa Spease Brush Mr. Brush was born March 29, 1890 in Marshall County.

In December, 1910, he married the former Della Renaud. To this union were born five daughters—Mrs. Robert (Delores) Boggs of Downey, Calif., Mrs. Floyd (Harriet) DeBoef of New Sharon and Mrs. Clyde (Mildred) Lisk. Mrs. Ollie (Lois) Terlouw and Mrs. Vernon (Bernice) Jay, all of Lynnville; and one son — Rex Brush of LeGrande.

Mr. and Mrs. Brush farmed in the Lynnville area and later were in business in Grinnell. Mrs. Brush died in August, 1952.

In November, 1954, Mr. Brush married the former Stella Rhuleman. They have lived in Mountain Home for the past nine years.

Survivors include his widow, five daughters, one son, a brother Jerald Brush of Kirksville, Mo., a sister — Mrs. Mary Heitink of Grinnell, 13 grandchildren and one great-grandchild.

Funeral services for Mr. Brush will be held at 2 p.m. Friday at the Lynnville Friends church. Hardin Funeral Home in New Sharon is in charge of the arrangements. The Rev. Peter Schuler will officiate.

Mrs. Howard Macy will be organist and Arnold Ratcliff, Kenneth Ratcliff and Ross Ratcliff will sing. Flower bearers will be Mrs. Gerald Beason, Mrs. Ernest Graham and Nellie Davis.
