

Rites held for Harold Bryan

Harold E. Bryan, 91, of Montezuma died Wednesday, Oct. 26, at Grinnell General Hospital.

Funeral services were conducted at 10:30 a.m. Saturday at the United Methodist Church of Montezuma, with the Rev. John Darlington officiating. Burial was at the Masonic-I.O.O.F. Cemetery with the Watts Funeral Home in charge of arrangements.

The son of John Burton and Nell Porter Bryan, he was born Nov. 16, 1891, at Montezuma. He graduated from Montezuma High School and from Grinnell College. He graduated from the University

of Colorado Law School in 1923.

On Dec. 21, 1913, he was married to Ida Mae Wells near Montezuma. Mr. Bryan had practiced law in Montezuma since 1923. He was a member of the United Methodist Church, Lafayette Masonic Lodge No. 52, Eastern Star, the Iowa State Bar Association and other professional organizations.

Survivors include his son, W. Burton Bryan of Canfield, Ohio; five grandchildren; and seven great-grandchildren.
