

## H. Buchmeier Dies At Home 1933 Near Kellogg

Kellogg, Ia., April 21, Special: Herman Buchmeier, resident of Rock Creek township since 1882, died at his home northeast of here Saturday afternoon at 1:00 o'clock following an illness of three years duration.

Mr. Buchmeier was born in Will county, Ill., February 19, 1859. He spent his early days in Illinois, coming to Jasper county at the age of 23 years and locating on a farm near here where he has lived since. He was united in marriage to Miss Lena Bockenthien March 28, 1883 and five children were born of this union, three of which preceded their father in death.

He united with the Lutheran church in early manhood and was a faithful and loyal attendant as long as his health would permit.

Funeral services were held at the home Monday afternoon at 2:00 o'clock with Rev. W. G. Weber, pastor of the local Lutheran church in charge. Burial was made in the Lutheran cemetery west of town.

Surviving relatives include his wife, Mrs. Lena Buchmeier, two sons, W. A. at home and Harry E. who resides north of town; two brothers, August of Kellogg and Henry of Monee, Illinois; two sisters, Mrs. Caroline Bobzin of Kellogg, and Mrs. Fred Ruhbeck of Monee, Illinois besides other relatives and a host of friends.
