## Joyce Buck, College Prof., Dead at 34

Miss Joyce Buck, 34, assistant professor of physical education for

women at Grinnell College, died Friday morning in a Cedar Rapids hospital after a long illness.

A 1957 Grinnell graduate who earned an M.S. degree from Indiana University in 1962, Miss Buck joined the Grinnell faculty in 1964. She had previously taught at high schools in River Rouge, Mich., Des Plaines, Ill., and Wyandotte, Mich., and had served as director of membership services with the American Institute of Park Executives in Wheeling, W.V.

Miss Buck was born in Chicago, Ill., on Sept. 22, 1935, and was graduated from Maine Township High School in Des Plaines, Ill., in 1953.

A memorial service for Miss Buck was held at 2:30 p.m. Sunday at the First United Presbyterian Church.

Howard R. Burkle conducted the service, and Richard H. Winters spoke.
