Aug 3,1900 —Olive Moody was born in Falmouth, Maine, Sept. 11, 1812, where she spent her childhood and young womanhood. She was married there in 1836 to Samuel Bucknam who with his wife scon after moved to Eastport, Maine. Mr. and Mrs. Bucknam continued their residence at Eastport till 1857, when they returned to Falmouth and lived there till 1874, ! and then moved to Grinnell.
