

Rites held for Mr. Buihner

Clarence Buihner, 88, a longtime Marshalltown resident, died Tuesday evening at Villa Del Sol nursing center, where he had been a patient since January.

Funeral services were conducted at 1:30 p.m. Saturday at the Estel-Perrin Chapel in Marshalltown, with burial at Chapel cemetery northeast of Green Mountain. Should friends desire, memorials in Mr. Buihner's name may be made to the American Cancer Society.

The son of Jacob and Mary Lunch Buihner, he was born

Feb. 3, 1892, in Tama County, where he received his education. On Nov. 29, 1916, he was married to Rose Kinsey at Albion. They farmed in the Chapel community in Marshall County and in Jasper County until retiring to Marshalltown in 1962. Mrs. Buihner preceded him in death in 1970. He was also preceded by a daughter in infancy, a son, Burdette, in 1962, and a brother, Floyd Buihner.

Survivors include five grandchildren and five great-grandchildren.
