

Mr. Burchland services held

Ed Burchland, 90, of Gilman, died Wednesday afternoon, Nov. 29, at the Marshall County Care Facility.

Funeral services were conducted at 10:30 a.m. Saturday at the Gilman United Methodist Church, with the Rev. Donna Van Maanen, pastor of the church, officiating. Organist was Janice Everts, and pallbearers were Calvin Burchland, Mike Burchland, Steven Freeborn, Tom Knoll, Raymond Larsen, Delmar Larsen, Gene Schnur and Hohn Wilhau.

Burial was in Prairie View Cemetery at Gilman.

The son of Nilsen and Louisa Olin Bjorklund, he was born near Stavanger, Norway, on Sept. 15, 1895. He attended schools at Høle, Stavanger, and came to the U.S. at the age of 17. He worked on farms in the Gilman area.

On Feb. 10, 1918, he was married to Thea Morstal Larsen at Marshalltown. The couple farmed near Laurel for a few years before moving to the farm west of Gilman.

Gilman United Methodist Church. He and his wife retired in 1962 and moved into Gilman.
