

Ed Burk, 86, Services Held

Ed Burk, 86, of 417 Mill St., Brooklyn, died early Saturday afternoon at Grinnell General Hospital, where he had been a patient the past two weeks.

The son of John F. and Louisa Maria Osterberg Burk, he was born July 3, 1886, in Rock Island County, Ill. He came to Iowa in 1901. On Oct. 29, 1919, he was married to Eva P. White, in Davenport.

Following their marriage, they lived in Poweshiek County. He did custom machine work for farmers for a number of years.

Mr. Burk is survived by his wife; two sons, Marvin of Spencer and Larry of Brooklyn; one daughter, Mrs. Paul (Esther) Marone of Batavia, N.Y.; six grandchildren; and one great-grandchild. He was preceded in death by his parents, one infant son, three sisters, and three brothers.

Funeral services were held at 2 p.m. Tuesday at the Nevenhoven Funeral Home in Brooklyn, with the Rev. Richard Menzel, pastor of the Presbyterian Church in Brooklyn, officiating. Burial was in Brooklyn's IOOF Cemetery.
