

Mr. Burlingame dies at 99

Carl Amos Burlingame, 99, died Wednesday, Oct. 29, at the Albia Manor.

The son of Andrew Cole and Mary Susan Forsyth Burlingame, he was born on July 11, 1887, on a farm in Monroe County. He was married to Margaret Ella Wylie on Dec. 21, 1910, at the home of her parents near Brooklyn.
