Alma Burroughs, age 84, a life long resident of the Newburg community, passed away Monday morning at a local hospital.

The daughter of John and Laura Sisco Newcomer, she was born on

September 19, 1881 in Jasper county, near Newburg. She attended the Hickory Grove No. 6, rural school and the Grinnell Academy.

On November 4, 1903 she was united in marriage to Richard M. Burroughs at her parents home near Newburg. Following their marriage they farmed in this community, and following their retirement they have made their home on their farm.

She was a member of the Newburg Congregational church.
