

Nona Burroughs rites Friday

Nona Burroughs, 82, of 627 East St., Grinnell, died Tuesday afternoon, March 4, at the Mayflower Home Health Care Center.

Graveside services will be conducted at 10 a.m. Friday at Hazelwood Cemetery, with the Rev. Philip J. Ramsfadt, pastor of the Grinnell United Church of Christ-Congregational, officiating. Friends are being asked to meet at the Smith Funeral Home at 9:30 a.m.

She was married to George A. Burroughs on Oct. 26, 1940. The marriage ended in divorce. Mrs. Burroughs was a member of the United Church of Christ-Congregational and the D.A.R. in Grinnell.

There are no immediate survivors. She was preceded in death by her parents and a brother, Verlin Adkins.
