Harry Buswell, Former Grinnell Resident, Dies

Word has been received here of the death of Harry Bert Buswell, 69, former Grinnell resident. He died April 3 at Wadsworth Veterans hospital, Los Angeles, Calif.

Burial was at Fort Rosencrans National cemetery, at Santiago.

The eldest son of Charles and Emma Jenkins Buswell, he was born March 2, 1896, at Grinnell. During World War I he served as an ammunition carrier with the U. S. Army.

In 1924, he was united in marriage with Marie May Everett, formerly of Iowa City.

He was a graduate of Grinnell high school and was employed at the utilities company in Los Angeles as foreman of a line installing crew.

He was a member of the First Congregational church of Grinnell and the American Legion.

Survivors include his widow, Marie; several nieces and nephews; numerous cousins; and an aunt, Mrs. James (Nancy Jane Jenkins) Buswell.

Preceding him in death were his parents; and two brothers, Arthur and Clyde.
