Henry Clay Buswell.

Henry Clay Buswell was born in Peoria, Ill., April 5th, 1836, and departed this life April 5th, 1911, having enjoyed days of being 75 years of age. The early part of his life was spent in Illinois, moving to Iowa in 1857. He was married to Mary Anne Pratt, Quaker, Ind., 1867. She departed this life November 10th, 1889. To this union were born five sons, C. P. and James Buswell, of this city.
