Henry Clay Biswell.
Henry Clay Biswell was born in Peoria, Ill., April 5th, 1839, and died at his home April 3rd, 1911, having lived 72 years or thereabouts. The early part of his life was spent in Illinois, moving to Rockford, where he married to Mary Jane Price, October 1st, 1857. She departed this life April 16th, 1889. To this union were born five sons, C. P. and James Biswell, of this city.
