

Elsie Campbell Dies; Funeral 3-24 Services Saturday 1960

Elsie Campbell, a resident of Grinnell for the past seven years, died yesterday at a local hospital following an extended illness.

Mrs. Campbell was the daughter of Thomas W. and Ella Devenspike Dixon, and was born on Feb. 23, 1875, at Fairfield. On February 2, 1897, she was married to James L. McConkey, who died in November 1907. In 1941 she was married to William Campbell, who died in 1947.

The deceased lived in Rock Island, Ill., most of her life. In 1953 she moved to Grinnell to make her home with her son, Sam McConkey.

Surviving relatives include her son, her grandson Tom McConkey, and her great granddaughter, Sandra McConkey, all of Grinnell; and a nephew, Grover Lowether, Sterling, Ill.

Funeral services for Mrs. Campbell will be Saturday at 2 p.m. at the James-Schalinske Funeral Home. The Rev. L. V. Keubrich will officiate, and the organist will be Mrs. Kathleen Heffner. Burial will be in Calvary cemetery.
