

Funeral Of Mrs. David Canaday Held At Kellogg

Funeral services for Mrs. David Canaday, former Kellogg resident, who died suddenly at her home in Hammond, Ind., Thursday night, were held at the Christian church here Sunday afternoon at 2 o'clock. Burial was made in Our Silent City.

Blanche Liesman was born in Kellogg September 27, 1897, the eldest daughter of Dr. and Mrs. B. Liesman. Her girlhood days were spent here and she was a graduate from the Newton high school in 1915. She attended State Teachers College at Cedar Falls, the State University at Iowa City, Drake University at Des Moines, and the University of California in preparation for teaching and served as instructor in the schools here, at Grinnell, Newton, Council Bluffs, Iowa, and at Hammond, Indiana.

She was united in marriage to David Canaday at Hammond July 13, 1931, and had made her home there since that time.

She was preceded in death by her father, who died January 18, 1935.

Surviving relatives include her husband; her mother, Mrs. Mamie Liesman of this place; two sisters, Miss Bertha and Miss Ruth of Des Moines; two brothers, Bruce of this place and Max, student at State University of Iowa.
