Funeral Services Here Today For Carl Carlson, 75

Carl H. Carlson, 75, of 620 Park Street, died Saturday afternoon at a local hospital.

Funeral services were held this afternoon (Monday) from St. John's Lutheran church with the Rev. Donald D. Spears, pastor, officiating. Vocal music was provided by Mrs. Peter Boeke and Mrs. Everett Gerrish, accompanied by Mrs. Marvin Nothnagel at the organ.
