

## Carroll Castorf

Carroll C. Castorf, 71, a native of rural Sully, died Monday, Jan. 15, at Valley Lutheran Hospital in Mesa, Ariz.

Funeral services were conducted Jan. 19, at St. Andrew's Lutheran Church in Sully, with the Rev. Robert E. Waters officiating. Organist was Nancy Toppenberg, and soloist was Russell Stravers.

He was a member of St. Andrew's Lutheran Church and had been a member of the Sully Lions Club.

Mr. Castorf is survived by his wife; two daughters, Lynn Wyma of Sully and Marsha Van Wyk of Prairie City; four grandchildren; one great-grandson; and three step-great-granddaughters.

He was preceded in death by his parents.
