Donald L. Caudill, 69, of 1422 Spring St., Grinnell, died of complications following abdominal surgery Tuesday, Sept. 15, at Mercy Hospital Medical Center in Des Moines.

The body has been cremated. A memorial service is set for 10:30 a.m. Saturday at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Grinnell. Dunn's Funeral Home of Des Moines is in charge of arrangements.

A native of Bonaparte, he lived most of his life in Des Moines, moving to Grinnell in 1991. He was a corporate secretary-treasurer of University Ave. Coal Co. in Des
