Pioneer Family

Miss Chamberlain belonged to an old Grinnell family. Her father, J. M. Chamberlain was one of the pioneers of Grinnell and was active in the community life. He was one of the early editors of The Grinnell Herald and during the last years of his life was librarian of the college library.

Miss Chamberlain grew up in Grinnell and was educated here. The Chamberlain home was located at the southwest corner of Park street and Seventh avenue where the Donald Renaud family now live.
