It was a shock to very many people in Grinnell when it was learned that Rodney W. Clark had passed away at his home on Broad street at an early hour on Wednesday evening. He retired soon after supper and a short time later his wife, attracted by a slight sound, came to him and found him very ill. A doctor was immediately summoned, but he died soon afterward.

The funeral will be held at 2:30 o'clock on Sunday afternoon, from the residence, conducted by Rev. P. F. Marston.

Mr. Clark was aged 78 years, 4 months and 29 days and was one of the earliest settlers of Poweshiek county. For a number of years he was in the lumber business here but retired in 1892. He had suffered for some time from Brights disease, but was able to be downtown on Wednesday and his death was entirely unexpected.
