Rites set for William Clark

William L. Clark, 48, of 120 Clark St., Reinbeck, died of cancer Tuesday, July 21, at Grundy County Hospital in Grundy Center.

Funeral services will be conducted at 10:30 a.m. Friday at the Smith Funeral Home, with the Rev. Raymond C. Lott of the Grinnell United Methodist Church officiating. Burial will be in Ivy Hill Cemetery at Malcom.

The son of Floyd and Lauretta B. Mehaffey Clark, he was born on Oct. 7, 1938, in Grinnell. He attended Grinnell schools, graduating from Grinnell High School in 1956. He served for two years with the U.S. Navy.
