James Collum, an aged and respected citizen of Brooklyn, died at the home of his son in Kansas City, April 16, 1900. The remains reached Brooklyn Sunday morning and the funeral was held from the Catholic church and interment here. The deceased was born in Ireland in 1824 and came to America in 1847 and to Lincoln township, this county, in 1867. He married Annie Gallagher, and to this union eight children were born, six sons living, all of whom were present at the funeral and acted as pall bearers. A Collum located in Brooklyn seven years ago and here he resided. Last fall he went to Kansas City to doctor cancer, but obtained little relief. He leaves an estate of 100 acres of land besides a large amount of personal property.
