

**Last Services For
Rev. George Alfred
Conrad Fri., 10 a. m.**

Funeral services for Rev. George Alfred Conrad, retired Congregational minister who passed away Monday noon will be held in the Congregational church Friday at 10 a. m. In the absence of the pastor, Rev. Leland W. Mann because of illness, Rev. Royal J. Montgomery will conduct the service assisted by Rev. Andrew Craig. Music will be provided by Mrs. Wayne Denny. Pall bearers will be Oliver Bean, Ben Buck, Lyle Hudnutt, Howard Moore, Chester Newcomer and George Stoker. Interment will be in the cemetery in Glidden, where his wife is buried.

Rev. Mr. Conrad was 92 years old and had made his home here for the past ten years with his daughter, Mrs. Bradford J. Clark, west of Grinnell, on the old Conrad homestead. He spent 35 years in the active ministry, having been ordained in Omaha, Neb., in 1891. He graduated from Wheaton college in 1868 with honors in Hebrew and from Chicago Theological seminary in 1891. Among his pastorates were Kingsley and Dunlap in Iowa and McCook, Norfolk and Oma-

ha, Neb. He came to Grinnell from Fort Shaw, Mont.

Rev. Mr. Conrad was born in Sterling, Minn., Dec. 3, 1859, the son of George and Mabel Shipman Conrad. He was married in Glidden June 10, 1891, to Alice Armstrong, who preceded him in death in 1926.

Surviving are three sons, George A. Conrad of Fort Shaw, Mont., Edward of Westfield, N. J., and Robert of Oakland, Calif., and his daughter, Mrs. Bradford Clark of Grinnell. Two other children preceded him in death. He is also survived by nine grandchildren and seven great grandchildren.
