Vera B. Copeland, 82, of Melbourne, formerly of the Grinnell area, died Friday, Nov. 1, at Marshalltown Medical and Surgical Center.

Funeral services were conducted Tuesday at the Melbourne United Methodist Church, with the Rev. Leonard Sjogren officiating. Burial was in Melbourne Cemetery.

The daughter of Van E. and Mary V. Maring Pugh, she was born Nov. 23, 1908, in Exline. She attended rural schools in Appanoose County and was a graduate of Exline High School.
