

Mrs. Geo. W. Cowden Dies In Cherokee

Mrs. G. W. Cowden passed away this morning at 4:15 at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Lorne Parker, at Cherokee. Services will be held Saturday afternoon from the local Congregational church at 2:30 o'clock. Interment will be beside her husband in Hazelwood.

Mrs. Cowden was the widow of the late G. W. Cowden, former superintendent of the Grinnell schools and later joint editor of The Grinnell Herald and still later editor of The Grinnell Register.

She was for many years one of Grinnell's prominent and influential women and her death will be mourned by many friends.
