## Nathaniel Washington Cox.

Nathaniel Washington Cox was born it Jacksonville, Ill., February 14, 1839, and died at his home near Drinkwater, Saskatchewan, Canadā, July 6, 1915, iged 76 years, 4 months, and 22 days.

He came to Iowa with his parents at the age of ten years, and settled near Kellogg, and was a resident of Jasper county until eight years ago, when he removed to Canada.

On Nov. 17, 1859, he was united in marriage to Mahala J. Carson, who survives him. To this union were born six children, two of whom died in intancy; the remaining four are, Mrs. E. P.
