Hospitalized a Month

Byard Craven, prominent poultry breeder and hatchery operator at Kellogg, died Saturday night at Community hospital in Grinnell where he had been a patient for the past month. Mr. Craven was 61 years old.

Well known locally and throughout this community, he was widely known for his poultry interests.

He was a lifelong resident of Kellogg and had served as the first president of the Iowa Poultry Improvement Association.

Funeral services will be held from the Kellogg Methodist church on Tuesday afternoon at 2 p.m. Burial will be in the Kellogg cemetery.

Surviving are a daughter, Mrs. Mary A. Oberlander of Newton, a brother and two sisters.
