Obituary of One of Washington Township's Native Sons.

James Joseph Creamer, son of Mr. and Mrs. J. P. Creamer, was born and grew to manhood in Washington township. His birth occurred January 31, 1893, and October 17, 1918. His life went out, his age being 25 years, 8 months and 16 days. Pneumonia was the cause. He had been ill but nine days.

The funeral was held Saturday at 10:30 o'clock at the home, conducted by Rev. M. J. Hannon. Burial was in Hazelwood. To mourn his early death, there remain his father and mother, and one brother, Jeffrey, who is at home, and a sister, Mrs. Francis Schmidz, and many other relatives and friends.

Joe Creamer was one of Washington township's best young men. He was young, active and lively and made friends everywhere. All who knew him liked him. He was a member of the Catholic church and tried in his life to exemplify their high and earnest ideals.
